## 1. President's Report - Ben Dare

Ben gave a brief summary of the club's activities during the past year. Notable events which Ben talked to included:

- Remarkables Ice & Mixed Festival 2016, which had our largest turnout of a festival up until that point;
- The NZAT and new team members, on the trials, selection of new team members, and their activities in the mountains;
- Canada Trip in January 2017, success of getting NZAT mentees successfully climbing difficult water ice up to and including grade WI6,
- The Marian Peak accident review, Ben talked about the work currently underway
  investigating the Marian Peak accident, where two team members, Conor Smith and Sarwan
  Chand died in a rock-climbing accident on the South Face. Ben noted the work being done
  on the review by the independent reviewers and the internal panel.

Jaz Morris moved that the minutes from 2016 be accepted by the Club, seconded by Steven Fortune and passed unanimously.

### 2. Treasurer's Report - Daniel Joll

Daniel circulated a number of copies of the club's financial statements for club members to review. See Schedule 1 for the complete financials for the ECC for the year ending 31<sup>st</sup> July 2017.

In addition to the financial statement, Daniel made a number of comments on the financial position of the Club:

- Aiming for the Expedition Capital Fund to reach \$1million
- The key source of fundraising for this is the festival itself.
- The ECC Capital Fund will be distributing a \$5000 grant from the investment's capital in 2017, with the grant amount increasing to \$7000 next year, where it will remain for a few years, before increasing to \$10,000 per year.
- Daniel also spoke to the other part of the Club money; that being the Team money, which is not made up of members' subscription fees or anything to do with members of the ECC. All the money in the NZAT fund is purely from private sponsorship, and this money is separate and divisible from the ECC and the capital fund money.
- Daniel continued this by noting the establishment of two trusts to protect the money from
  untoward and unscrupulous handling. These two trusts are the ECC Capital Fund trust,
  which will hold the money of the ECC Capital Fund and distribute the capital to the
  designated expedition each year. The other trust is the NZAT trust, which comprises the
  money donated by private entities towards the NZAT. This fund will also be managed by
  trustees who will distribute the income in accordance with NZAT policy.

Jaz Morris moved that the financial statements be accepted by the Club, seconded by Steven Fortune and passed unanimously.

#### 3. NZAT Subcommittee Report – Steven Fortune

Steve summarised the events of the NZAT over the past year, including the trips, events, activities of NZAT members.

He also spoke to the accident review, and noted that it is open for submissions by affected individuals who wish to comment.

### 4. Festival & Events Subcommittee Report – Alastair McDowell

Alastair discussed some of the trips undertaken by the club in the past year, including:

- Cloudy Peak trip run by Sarwan Chand and Steven Fortune, and attended by a number of other club members;
- Arapiles trip, attended by 5-6 club members of the Easter holiday period.

Alastair also noted the upcoming trip planned by a couple of club members – Tim Elson & Reg Measures to the Garwhal Himalaya, as well as briefly mentioning the 2017 Remarkables Ice & Mixed Festival.

### 5. Publications Subcommittee Report - Delivered by Daniel Joll in lieu of Kester Brown

Daniel briefly summarised the sources of club publications, notably:

- The ECC Website;
- The NZAT Website;
- The NZAT Facebook page;
- The ECC Facebook group;
- the NZAT Instagram page.

Daniel also talked about the desire that the ECC Facebook group be a place for information on climbing, conditions, and material related to the club and club members. Part of this is that it is a safe space where there will be no tolerance for trolling, or other deleterious activities, and the page will be moderated in accordance with these ideals.

#### 6. General Business

One matter of general business which was raised was the proposed trips to present presentations and submit for a vote at the 2017 Remarkables Ice & Mixed Festival 2017. Three trips were presented at the AGM, and all were approved by all members present at the AGM to be valid proposals which warrant proposition and voting at the Festival. The proposals were:

A) Reg Measures & Timothy Elson – Trip to India Himalaya in the Kishtwar province in October 2018. Objectives include peaks up to 6500m. Estimated costs are \$4600 US in country costs with approximately \$2000 NZD required for flights to India.

Moved by Ben Dare, seconded by Steve Fortune.

B) Gemma Wilson & Rose Pearson – Trip to Alaska in April 2018. Their objective is the Moonflower Buttress on Begguya/Mt Hunter in Denali National Park. They propose to share a base camp at the Kahiltna International Airport for anyone who wishes to join.

Moved by Daniel Joll, seconded by Ben Dare.

C) Alastair McDowell & Caleb Jennings – Trip to Patagonia (El Chalten) in February 2018. They propose that ECC team collect in El Chalten and climb individual objectives. Approximate cost would be \$5000-\$6000.

The only other matter of general business was a call for a vote on accepting Festival Volunteers as honorary members of the ECC for the 2017-2018 year and waiving the payment of membership fees.

Motion moved by Jaz Morris, seconded by Steven Fortune, and approved unanimously.

President is a 3-year fixed term role, and Ben Dare was re-elected in 2016, so his term expires in 2019.
